RESOLUTION 2020-

MUNICIPAL RESOLUTION TO WITHDRAW FROM 2004 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY ORGANIZATION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Knox County and its municipalities and townships passed resolutions in 2004 to adopt an Emergency Management Agency organization under Section 5502.26 of the Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, under those resolutions, the municipalities and townships make contributions to fund the emergency management agency, with Knox County paying the balance of funds necessary to operate the agency; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5502.26 of the Revised Code, the Emergency Management Agency operates with an Executive Committee composed of representatives of member political subdivisions, and

WHEREAS, the Knox County Commissioners and the Executive Committee of the Emergency Management Agency met in joint session on November 5, 2020 and discussed dissolving the current organization and reorganizing the Emergency Management Agency under the control of the Knox County Commissioners pursuant to Revised Code Section 5502.271; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Committee discussed the advantages of streamlining the operating structure of the Emergency Management Agency and relieving townships and municipalities of any obligation to provide funding while receiving the same services from the Emergency Management Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Committee voted unanimously to recommend to all member political subdivisions that they pass resolutions to withdraw from the current Emergency Management operating resolution on or before December 17, 2020;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Centerburg Council, meeting in regular session on December 7, 2020, that Centerburg is withdrawing from the current Emergency Management Resolution (No. 1042-2004) effective December 31, 2020.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution is declared an emergency and shall take effect immediately and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
