RESOLUTION NO. 2019- 04

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO BID THE PAVEMENT REPAIRS AND TO APPLY FOR COUNTY PERMISSIVE FUNDS AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has budgeted money for 2019 for the street pavement repairs and replacement, which has been recommended by the Public Service Committee;

WHEREAS, Council has access to additional County Permissive Funds which could also be used for street pavement repairs and replacement;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Centerburg, Ohio as follows:

Section 1: That the Village Administrator has the authority to work with the Village Engineer to solicit bids for street pavement repairs and replacement in conformance with the Village street paving plan.

Section 2: That the Village Administrator has the authority to apply for County Permissive Funds to add to the Village budgeted amount of \$53,100 to increase said amount available for street pavement repairs and replacement for which the Village Administrator is seeking bids.

<u>Section 3.</u> Council declares this to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, such emergency specifically rising out of the need to provide safe and well-maintained streets and get the street paving completed during the warm weather months.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance is declared an emergency and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
